<b>June 26</b>	Deadline for Optional Draft Review Validated Data distributed to campuses
<b>July 19</b>	Strategy Survey Completion Deadline Optional Reviews returned to campuses
<b>October 8</b>	Final update reports due to System Office
<b>December 2</b>	Updates submitted to Governor's Office

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# NARRATIVE REPORT

This is where you tell us what you've done and how it has gone for 2018-2019

- Format is flexible; template no longer required
- Structure is largely the same as last year
- No limits on strategies; page limits are back (10)

# NARRATIVE REPORT

## Section 1: Institutional Mission and Student Body Profile

- Not a comprehensive review of your data and mission but a targeted discussion that explains:
  - Who you are
  - Why you are focusing your work where you are
  - Connect data tables to work you discuss later



# NARRATIVE REPORT

## Section 2: Momentum Year Update

- Discuss the major actions undertaken as part of your Momentum Year plan.
  - What components are still in the development or implementation phases?
  - In addition to other elements, please describe strategy taken in supporting students making a purposeful choice of a program or focus?
  - Discuss any early results to date.

# NARRATIVE REPORT

## Section 3: Other Institutional High-Impact Strategies, Activities & Outcomes

The narrative report section is intended to answer a few specific questions about your institution's top priority completion work:

- What are you working on?
- Why is it important?
- What activities have you undertaken?
- What progress are you making?
- What have you learned?

Each strategy should be it's own element of your report.

# NARRATIVE REPORT

## Section 4: Observations and Next Steps

- Briefly let us know what is working, what is not, and what changes you intend to make in the coming year.
- Should be across the full scope of your work.

# NARRATIVE REPORT

## Section 5: Student Success Team

- NEW.
- List the members of your student success team (this list does not count against your total pages)
- Gives us a comprehensive sense of who is working on what work on campus.

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# REVIEW & SUBMITTING YOUR REPORT

# OPTIONAL REVIEW

- Optional review
  - Institutions wishing to have a review must submit their reports by **June 26**
  - Focused feedback on activities

# Submitting Your Update

Updates should be one Word file (no PDFs) from the President's Office (no longer need a signed letter). Appendices should be a separate Word file.
